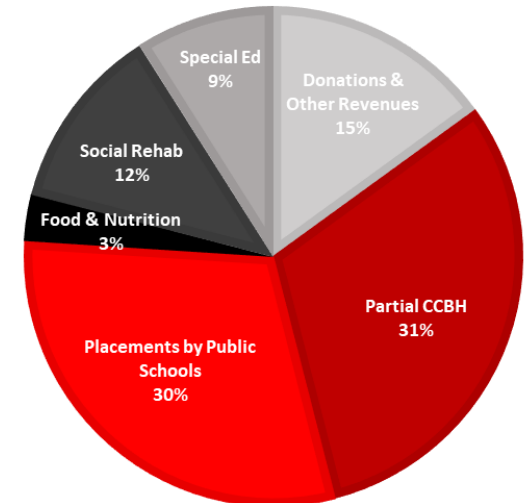


## 41 YEARS OF LOVE AND SERVICE!

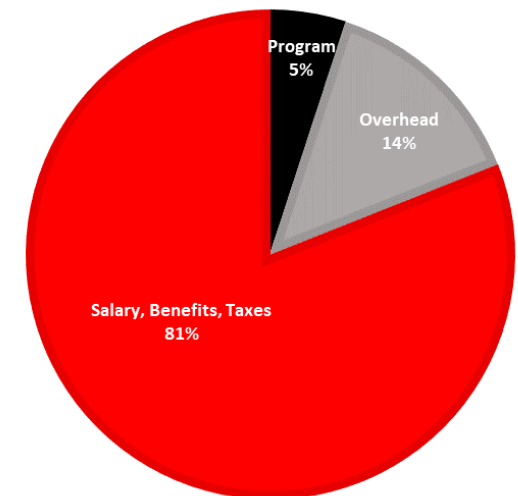
